The scholars will attend different session led by various managers and each will focus on one aspect of that manager's curriculum.
TRANSPORTATION TO BE USED: ASK Academy will provide group transportation for all scholars, adult chaperones may need to drive themselves or carpool with another chaperone (ASK will be happy to arrange carpools).
COST: \$60.00 per scholar, adult chaperones are free, free and reduced lunch status are eligible for a 50% scholarship
Registration Deadline: August 22, 2019 (permission slip and payment)

The undersigned as parent or legal guardian of _____, does hereby give permission for the above named individual to attend the described activity.

In order to be eligible for participation, the scholar must NOT receive ANY disciplinary referrals between Monday August 9th, 2019 and the date of the event (Thursday September 12th). If a scholar receives ANY disciplinary referral in the designated time period they will no longer be eligible to attend the field trip, and their registration fee will NOT be refunded. The NO REFUND policy is because all fees collected will already have been allocated toward food and transportation.

As a condition of attending the described activity, I do hereby release The ASK Academy Charter School and all its organizations, as well as their officers, agents and employees, from any and all claims, demands, actions, or causes of action due to death, injury, or illness, in any way, arising from the above described activity, including, but not limited to transportation to and from the event.

I further agree that the financial responsibility for securing care, in case of injury resulting from participation in the program, is a matter between the participant and his/her health care provider, and that The ASK Academy cannot pay health care providers for treatment of any injuries. It is further agreed, that the participant will assume all legal responsibility for their personal safety and actions while participating in the program and while traveling to and from the program activities.

Jemez Camping Trip Expectations of Behavior

While on any excursion learning experience, all ASK scholars are considered representatives of the ASK Academy. They are expected to conduct themselves as positive examples for the entire duration of the trip.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Check in with your assigned manager at the designated times
2. Do not enter any tent except your own
3. Do not take, borrow, damage, hide, or in any way touch other people's belongings
4. Wear appropriate clothing at all times (inappropriate can include clothing graphics, designs, sizes, and/or quantity)
5. Do not enter 'off limits areas' as designated by a chaperone
6. Do not use offensive or insensitive language
7. Do not go anywhere by yourself, ALWAYS have a buddy
8. Do not go anywhere without the approval of a manager
9. Quiet hours start at 10 pm, all scholars must be in their tents
10. NO food in tents – ever!
11. NO Airsoft Guns, NO Knives, NO weapons of ANY type
12. Do not collect, damage, or disturb any plants, animals, or rocks – this is illegal!
13. Stay on the marked trails
14. Be respectful of the sites
15. Be respectful of other visitors
16. Any directions given to you by a manager, parent chaperone, or park ranger MUST be followed immediately
17. All medications must be checked in with administrator in charge.

Any violation of the above rules will result in disciplinary action by the General Manager. Please be advised that it may also result in the Parent/Guardian being contacted and required to come retrieve their scholar. This will be approximately a 3 hour round trip from Albuquerque/Rio Rancho.

By signing below I acknowledge that I have read and understand all of the rules listed above. Furthermore, I agree to abide by the consequences for violation of the rules determined by the general manager, including the early retrieval of my scholar. If a scholar's camping trip is terminated prematurely there will NOT be a refund of the trip fee.
